CSR COMMITTEE:

M/s Lalwani Ferro Alloys Ltd. believes that Corporate Social Responsibility means that a business should do more for the well-being of society than required in an economic and legal sense. We agree that corporate social responsibility, i.e. contribution towards social welfare is a vital part of daily business practice. In today's fast-paced world each business, whether big or small, needs to have a CSR program in place.

As per Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013 which pertains to the CSR law for the companies, we have constituted a Corporate Social Responsibility Committee with Independent Directors. Ms. Venus Kedia and Ms. Priya Gupta are the Independent Directors of the Company and the members of the CSR Committee along with Mr. Sandeep Lalwani as the Chairman of the Committee.

CSR EXPENSES:

As per Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013 every company, on which CSR is applicable, shall spend, in every financial year, at least 2% of the average net profits of the company made during the three immediately preceding financial years towards the CSR. As per the provision during the financial year 2023-24 the company was liable to spend an amount of Rs. 1.97 Crores toward the CSR. In the financial year 2022-23, the company spent an excess of Rs. 12 Lacs. Hence, in the financial year 2023-24 the company was liable to spend an amount of Rs. 1.85 Crores.

During the financial year 2023-24, the company has spent an amount of Rs. 2.31 Crores on seven different projects. The company spent an excess of Rs. 0.46 Lacs which will be set off in the next financial year. These projects were recommended by the CSR Committee and the Company had given preference to the Promotion of Education, Development of Rural Areas, and Eradication of Hunger.

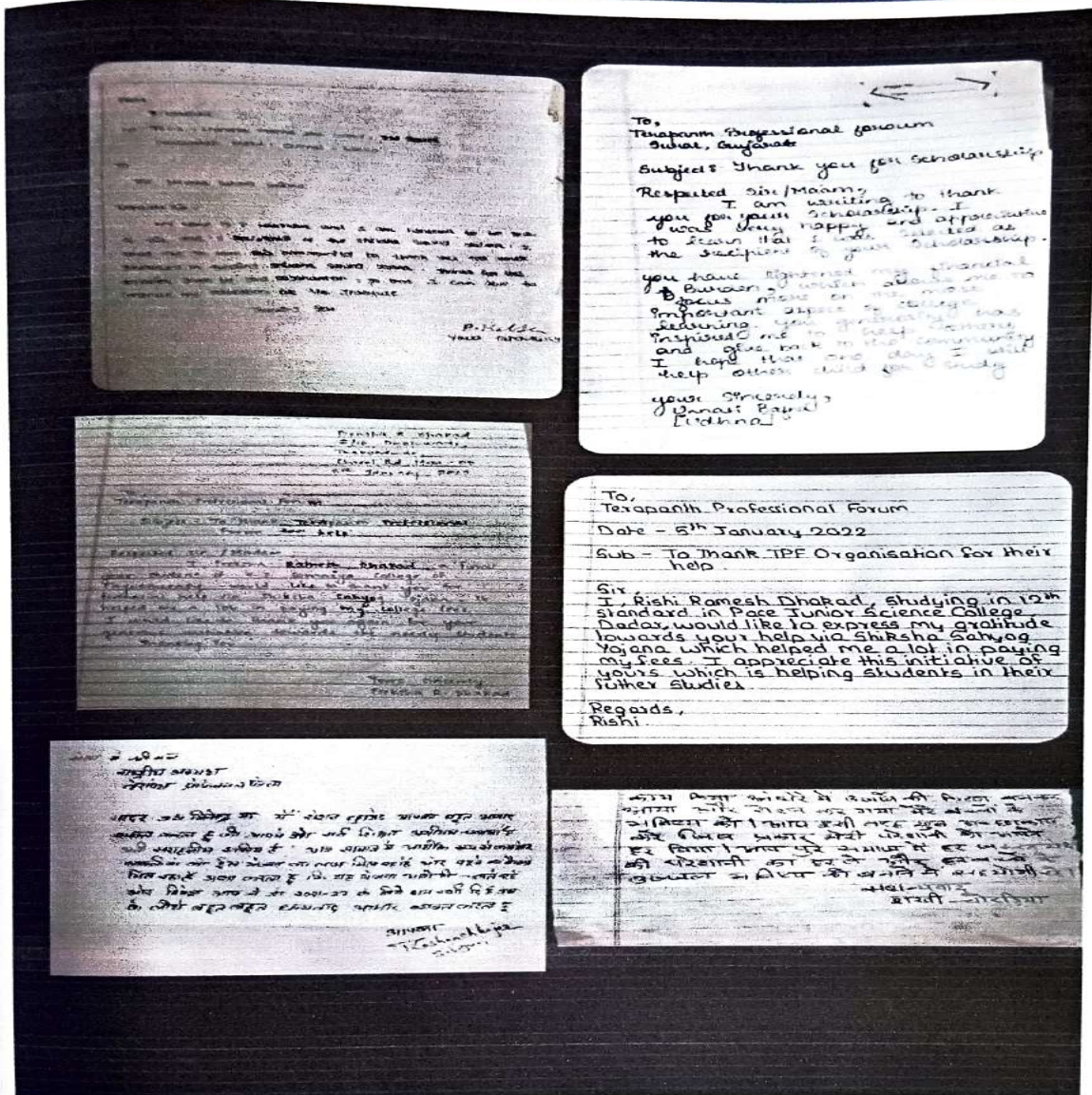
